NORMAL ANATOMY

VESTIBULAR PAPILLOMATOSIS

Multiple small soft papillae, variable in number, located in the vestibule and medial labia minora. They can vary in size with some being up to 6mm in length and 1-2 mm wide. They are skin coloured and can occur in isolation or can cover the vestibule. As they are a normal finding no treatment is required.
